1. Eleanor drafted a budget slide presentation and budget documentation to justify how the Board wants to use AHA money. She reviewed the

- proposals: 1) define a baseline of savings; 2) propose budgets for each committee; 3) award annual scholarship of \$1,000/year (when possible); 4) Commit to ICA and PARBICA membership and 5) modestly increase membership fee.
- 2. The budget presentation and documentation will need to be sent out to the listserv prior to the annual meeting as not many attend the annual meeting when its held on a neighbor island.
- 3. The Board suggested to keep the institution fee instead of proposing a membership vote to remove it from the bylaws. Institutions get recognition for being members.
